



How much you will have to pay for the care services you receive

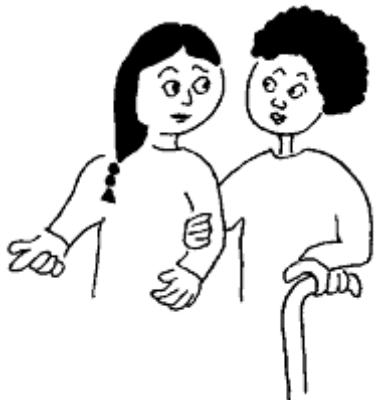

What is this leaflet about?

This leaflet tells you how much, if anything, you will have to pay for the social care services you receive from us.



This includes home care and personal support services, day services, transport and any meals.

How much will I have to pay?



The amount you will have to pay depends on how much money you have.



We will help you to fill in a form telling us how much money you have.

Some of the benefits or allowances you receive will be counted but some won't.

What if I have money saved up?

If you have savings this could also affect how much you have to pay.



The more savings you have, the more you might have to pay. We don't count the value of the house you live in but if you own other property that will be counted.



When we have worked all this out, we will take off an amount for your everyday living costs and then look at how much is left.



The person who supports you will help you to understand how we do this.

How much does it cost?

We will tell you how much you have to pay each week. Below is a list of our charges. All charges are looked at again in April each year.

Everyone has to pay the charges for meals and transport but what you are asked to pay towards any home care and day care you receive may be a lot less than the charges below.

Home care and personal support services	from £12.00 per hour
Day Services	
Kempston Centre & Gadsby Street including transport	£66.00 per day
Kempston Centre & Gadsby Street excluding transport	£54.00 per day
Goldington Road and Conduit Road Day Centre including transport	£32.60 per day
Goldington Road and Conduit Road Day Centre excluding Transport	£18.17 per day
Other meals	£5.00
Respite care or short stays	
Age 18 to 24	£6.60 per night
Age 25 to 59	£8.80 per night
Age 60+	£11.80 per night

How do I pay?

We will send you a bill every four weeks. You can pay this in lots of different ways.



You can pay over the phone using your bank card.

Or you can have it taken direct from your bank account.



We will help to work out the best and easiest way for you to pay.

Do you need help with this?



If you need help with any of this information the person who supports you will try to explain it to you.

What if I'm not happy?
